Collective agreement

On the basis of the decision of the Tripartite Committee for Labor Affairs dated 31/1/2012 inviting the representatives of workers and employers in the garment industry to negotiate among themselves to agree on the mechanism of implementation of this resolution And the stages of implementation and any other details agreed upon between them before the date of 1/3/2012. So that what was reached is considered an integral part of this decision to be implemented from 1/2/2012.

It has been agreed between the undersigned parties on:

1. It was agreed to the gradual increase of wages for Jordanian workers in two stages so that the wage of the Jordanian worker will not be less than (170) dinars as of the date of 1/2/2012 and will become (190) JD as of 1/1/2013 considering this increase as the cost of living for Jordanian workers.
2. It was agreed to link this gradual increase in wages with the issuance of a decision of the tripartite committee, except the clothing sector of the minimum wage for the year 2011.
3. - It was agreed that a sectoral collective agreement will be signed between the parties signed below aiming at achieving equality among all workers in this sector before 1/3/2012.
