Collective Labor Agreement

In view of the importance of the textile sector in supporting the national economy and maintaining the consultations and negotiations between the undersigned to improve the working conditions and conditions of workers in the spinning and weaving sector, the undersigned agreed as follows:

1- To grant the migrant workers in the spinning and weaving sector the following increments:

A- An increase of Five-dinars for each worker who spent a full year until the date of 1/2/2012.

B - An Increase of (10) dinars per worker who spent two full years until the date of 1/2/2012.

C- An Increase of the fifteen dinars per worker who spent three full years until the date of 1/2/2012.

D- An increase of twenty dinars per worker spent four years and more until the date of 1/2/2012.

E- The above increases are implemented from 1/2/2012.

2. The undersigned shall continue to negotiate with a view to achieving the best application of international standards for workers in the field of equality.
