### Collective Employment Agreement under the provisions of the Jordanian Labor law No.8 for the year 1996

As the second party has submitted to the first party the demands of the workers and the interest of the parties to maintain an atmosphere and an environment of friendship, mutual understanding and appreciation between the parties, Emphasizing the consolidation of good working relations between the two parties and the availability of joint concern for the continuity of development and promotion of work in this institution in order to develop and provide the national economy.

In light of the positive spirit and friendly relations that prevailed in the atmosphere of the meetings of the negotiations and in order to maintain the continuation of these relations between the two parties and the result of the flexibility was shown by the parties and understand each other's interest.

A settlement was reached for the workers' demands and the two sides agreed on the following:

# The preamble of this agreement is considered as an integral part and read with it as one part.

1. The first party is committed to involve employees with health insurance for those who wish and do not have any other health insurance and from the date of renewal of the tender contract.

2. The first party will pay a working allowance allowance of JD (10) per month for all employees and act as of renewal of each tender contract.

3. The first party committed to pay an annual increase, according to the rate of inflation in the country, which is determined by the Central Bank of Jordan annually.

4. The first party is committed to deduct one JD per month from each employee who wishes to join the union and deducts for the benefit of the union.
