relations, and to maintain constructive dialogue aimed at serving the

private education sector, providing it with suitable working conditions, In

order to maintain these relations, several meetings have been held with an

atmosphere of understanding, cooperation, positive spirit

appreciation of the common interests of each party, In order to reach a

collective work contract Establishes principles and frameworks for the

establishment of a common relationship to promote this sector And its

employees on a clear and transparent basis that defines the rights and

duties of each party.

After a discussion and exchange views, it was agreed that:

1- Improving the health insurance contract as of next year 2016.

2. The two parties agreed that the first party to study the mechanism to

grant the annual increase of staff and the financial position of the

company for the year 2016.

3. The first party shall abide by the minimum wage, currently in force and

issued by the tripartite committee under the provisions of the Jordanian

Labor Law.

4. The first party agreed to increase the scholarships for the sons of the

employees of the company to become 20 scholarships annually to obtain

a bachelor's degree or diploma from universities and institutes of Jordan

to start from next year 2016.

5. The first party is committed to employ an appropriate number of

people with special needs in accordance with the legal requirements and

the needs of the company.

6. The Parties shall continue to represent this contract and any dispute

arising therefrom.
